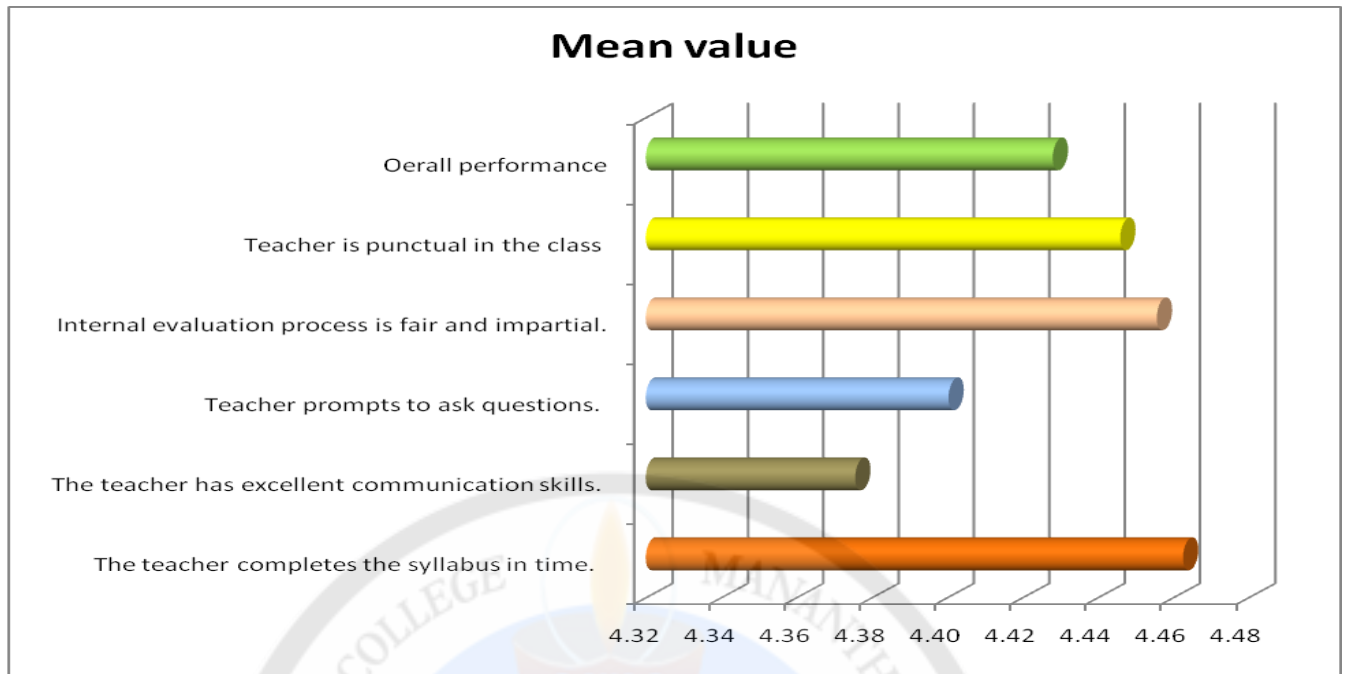
FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS

This questionnaire has two parts. The first part has five questions and is intended to collect information relating to students' satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation. The remaining five questions intend to collect students' satisfaction regarding the facilities in the college.

Students' opinion on various questions are measured in a five point scale(1. Strongly disagree 2. Disagree 3. Neither agree nor disagree 4. Agree and 5. Strongly agree). A random samples from 430 students from all the departments of the college were collected. The data collected has been analysed and the results given below.

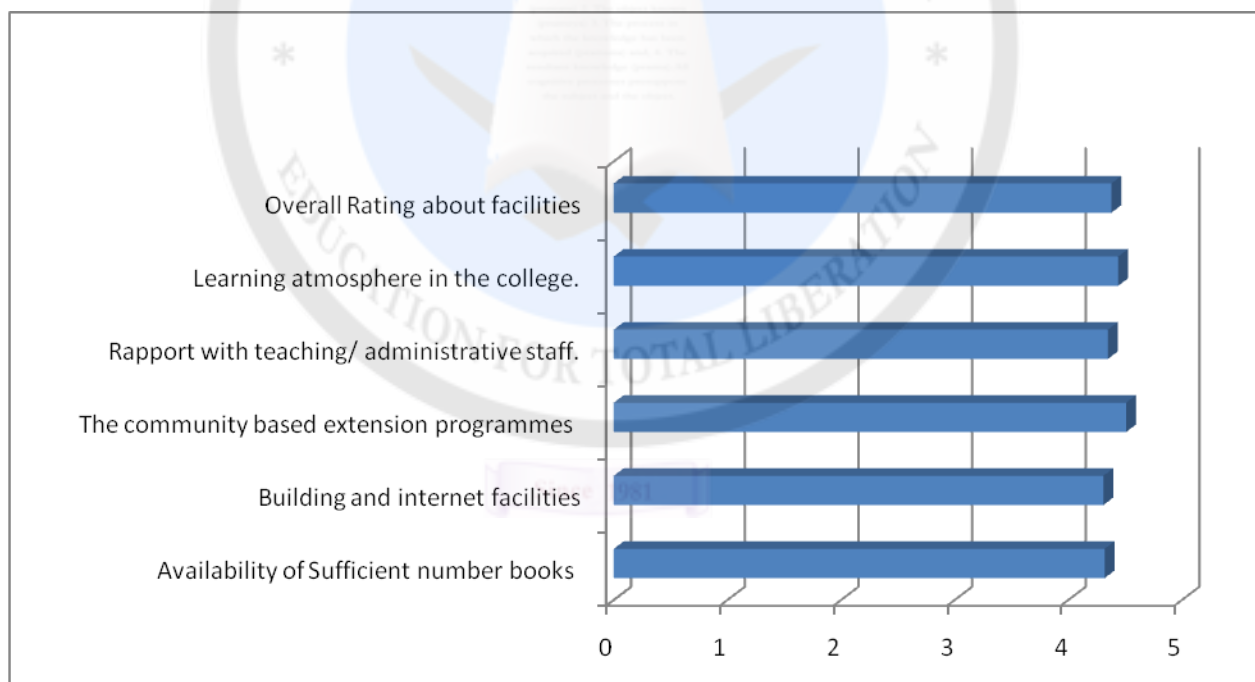


The analysis shows that the analysis shows that students are satisfied with timely completion of syllabus by teacher. The mean score of this component is obtained as 4.46 with a standard deviation of 0.3637. Regarding the, communication skills of teachers the mean score is 4.4356 with standard deviation 0.3739. It shows that the students are satisfied with it. When we consider the Teacher prompts to ask questions, the mean score is 4.4 with standard deviation 0.341 and it is satisfactory. Regarding the component fair and impartial internal evaluation system, the mean score is 4.45 with standard deviation 0.3761 which is almost at the very good rating. Regarding the punctuality of teacher, the mean score is 4.44 with standard deviation 0.32920 which is at the very good rating. It can be concluded that overall satisfaction of students about teacher's performance is satisfactory.

It is clear from the table that the students Strongly Agree with the statement, the community based extension programmes carried out by the college through its various

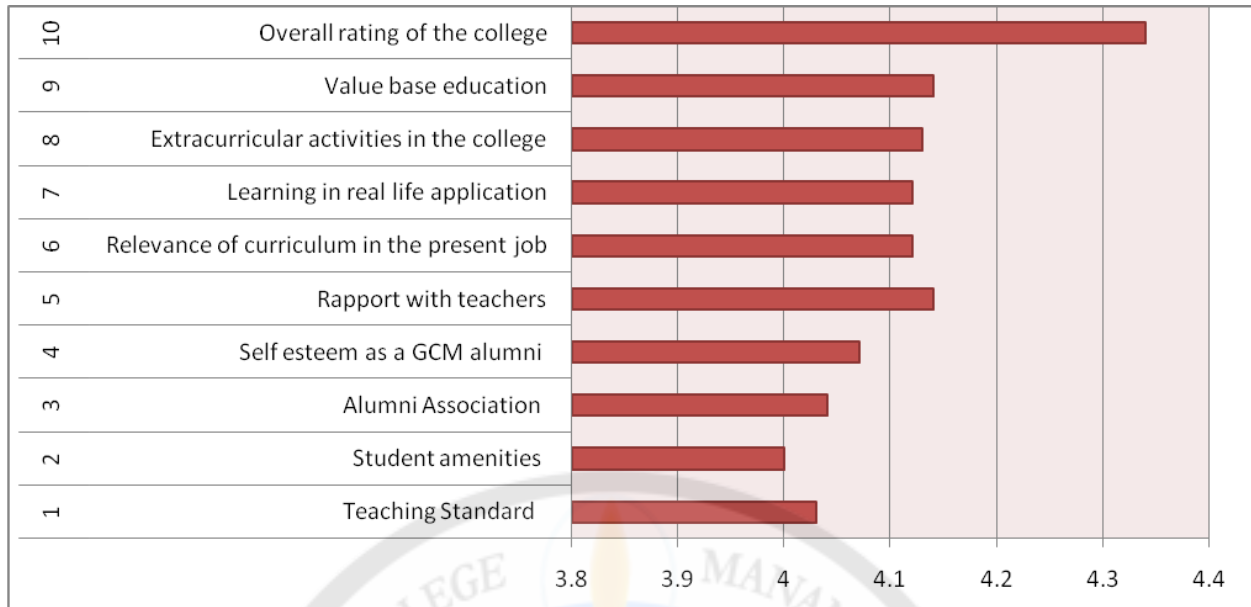

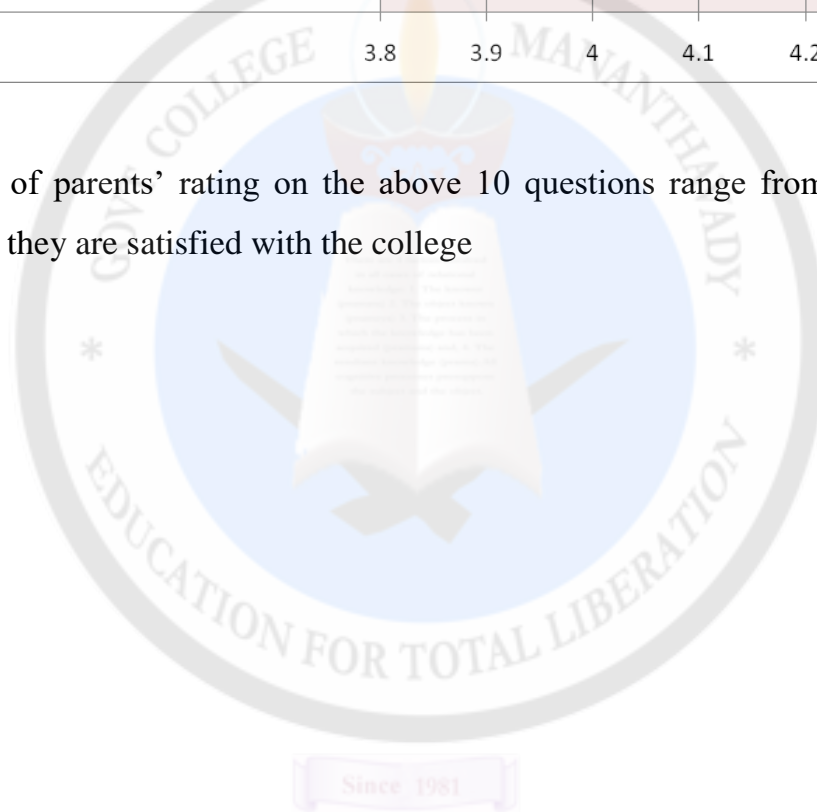
FEEDBACK FROM PARENTS
